The Lath Pavilion was designed to be an outdoor community space and event venue. Completed in 1980 and the winner of the 1982 American Institute of Architects Honor Award, architect Robert Frankeberger's design was inspired by 19th century botanical conservatories and gazebos which were common features of early Phoenix and Victorian architecture. The Pavilion is the venue for many events throughout the year, including weddings, community festivals, and even yoga classes!
